A Catholic Dictionary of Theology. 3 vols. London; New York: Thomas Nelson, 1962.

Three of the proposed four volumes have appeared thus far (the third volume published in 1971). Long, signed articles by scholars in respective fields; selective bibliographies. A work projected with the approval of the Catholic hierarchy of England and Wales. Reflects the thought and interests of Vatican II.

Balz, Horst Robert, Gerhard Krause and Gerhard Müller, eds. *Theologische Realenzyklopädie*. Berlin; New York: de Gruyter, 1977.

Thirty-three volumes have been completed thus far. Each volume is separately indexed and a cumulative index for volumes 1-27 is available. Many of the signed articles are of journal length and contain extensive bibliographies. The essays are concerned more with theological analysis than with historical development. Includes a volume giving a helpful listing of abbreviations used in theological research.

Betz, Hans Dieter, ed. *Religion in Geschichte Und Gegenwart : Handwörterbuch Für Theologie Und Religionswissenschaft*. 4th ed. 4 vols. Tübingen: Mohr Siebeck, 1998.

The most recent updated edition of RGG. 4 volumes have so far been published.

Buchberger, Michael, Josef Höfer and Karl Rahner, eds. *Lexikon Für Theologie Und Kirche*. 2nd ed. 14 vols. Freiburg,: Herder, 1957.

Ten volumes plus an index volume and three supplements. The index includes an extensive subject index, an analytical index, a geographical index, and a list of contributors indicating entries contributed. Contains mostly short, signed articles, but does have some longer essays. Selective bibliographies. Three supplementary volumes treat Vatican II.

Buchberger, Michael, Walter Kasper and Konrad Baumgartner, eds. *Lexikon Für Theologie Und Kirche*. 3., völlig neu bearb. Aufl., ed. 12 vols. Freiburg im Breisgau: Herder, 1993.

A new edition of Lexikon fuer Theologie und Kirche. Nine volumes have been published so far and include post-Vatican II material.

Catholic University of America., ed. *New Catholic Encyclopedia*. 19 vols. New York: McGraw-Hill, 1967.

Nineteen volumes including index (v.15), and four supplements, covering the years 1967-74 (v.16), the change in the church (v.17), the years 1978-88 (v. 18) and 1989-95 (v. 19). Signed articles, mostly with bibliographies. Covers the major figures, doctrines, and events which have influenced Roman Catholic history, with emphasis on English speaking regions.

Christman, J. Creighton and William Sailer, eds. *Religious and Theological Abstracts*. Vol. 1- Mar. 1958-. Myerstown, Pa.: Religious and Theological Abstracts Inc., 1958.

Articles from three hundred journals are abstracted quarterly and classified into four general sections (historical theology, systematic theology, biblical studies, and practical theology). Includes cumulative subject and author indices for each volume.

Edwards, Paul, ed. *The Encyclopedia of Philosophy*. Reprint ed. 8 vols. New York: Macmillan, 1972.

Extensive thematic and historical coverage. Treats a broad spectrum of philosophical issues, but from an essentially Anglo-American perspective. Articles are by major contemporary philosophers and scholars; longer entries include bibliographies, some annotated.

Eliade, Mircea and Charles J. Adams, eds. *The Encyclopedia of Religion*. 16 vols. New York, N.Y.: Macmillan, 1987.

Fifteen volumes with index. Signed articles by major scholars. Wide coverage of the ideas, rituals, events, symbols, and persons which make up the world's religions. Particularly valuable as an introduction to the history, basic concepts and practices of non-Christian religions. Brief bibliographies.

Fabella, Virginia and R. S. Sugirtharajah, eds. *Dictionary of Third World Theologies*. Maryknoll, N.Y.: Orbis Books, 2000.

This reference work makes available in one volume the breadth and richness of the theological contributions of the peoples of Africa, Asia, the Caribbean, Latin America, the Pacific, and the minority and indigenous peoples of the world. The editors commissioned theologians from the Third World to write more than 150 entries on themes from Christian theology and religious studies, including spiritualities, cultural and social issues, biblical interpretation, and theological categories. The entries are inclusive of geographical, cultural, and denominational/confessional variations and the contributors include members of the Roman Catholic, Protestant, Orthodox, and Mar Thoma (India) churches (quoted from Blackwell)

Fahlbusch, Erwin, ed. *Evangelisches Kirchenlexikon : Internationale Theologische Enzyklopädie*. 3rd ed. 5 vols. Göttingen: Vandenhoeck & Ruprecht, 1985.

Four volumes with index. Lengthy, signed articles by prominent scholars. Select bibliographies include journal citations. Its English translation is being published as *The Encyclopedia of Christianity*.

Fahlbusch, Erwin and Geoffrey William Bromiley, eds. *The Encyclopedia of Christianity*. 2 vols. Grand Rapids, Mich.; Leiden: W.B. Eerdmans; Brill, 1999.

The English translation of *Evangelisches Kirchenlexikon*. Two of the proposed five volumes have been published. Lengthy, signed articles by prominent scholars. Select bibliographies include journal citations

Ford, David, ed. *The Modern Theologians: An Introduction to Christian Theology in the Twentieth Century*. 2nd ed. Cambridge, Mass.: Blackwell, 1997.

Essays written by respected scholars. Part I, divided into four sections, looks at Continental European theologians many of whom have achieved "classic" status. The remaining seven

parts discuss theologians and theological movements outside of Continental Europe.
Extensive bibliographies follow each essay.

Galling, Kurt and Hans Campenhausen, eds. *Die Religion in Geschichte Und Gegenwart; Handwörterbuch Für Theologie Und Religionswissenschaft*. 3rd ed. 7 vols. Tübingen: Mohr, 1957.

Six volumes plus an index. Known as the RGG, all three editions are important because of the status of the contributors and the references in the bibliographies. The index volume gives extensive treatment to both contributors and subject matter.

Harvey, Van Austin. *A Handbook of Theological Terms*. New York: Macmillan, 1964.

Concise definitions of historic theological terms

Hastings, James, ed. *Encyclopaedia of Religion and Ethics*. 13 vols. New York: Scribner, 1951.

Thirteen volumes. A comprehensive work, now somewhat dated. Broad coverage of persons, issues, and events in religion and ethics. Articles by major figures of the turn of the century. Good bibliographies, excellent indexing.

Herzog, Johann Jakob, Albert Hauck and Hermann Caselmann, eds. *Realenzyklopädie Für Protestantische Theologie Und Kirche*. 3rd ed. 24 vols. Leipzig,: J. C. Hinrichs, 1896.

Twenty-two volumes, including index (v.22), plus two supplementary volumes. Long, signed articles by specialists in respective fields, most with bibliographies. Still of historical value, though now rather dated.

Jackson, Samuel Macauley and Lefferts Augustine Loetscher. *The New SchaffHerzog Encyclopedia of Religious Knowledge*. 13 vols. Grand Rapids, Mich.: Baker, 1949.

Twelve volumes plus an index volume. This edition is a revision and translation of the third edition of the Realencyclopaedie (see above). Considered to be strong on classical theological positions, church history, and biography, but rather weak on biblical studies. Extensive bibliographies found throughout the volumes. This reference text is supplemented by the Twentieth Century Encyclopedia of Religious Knowledge (Lefferts A. Loetscher, editor. Grand Rapids: Baker, 1955. Ref. BR95.T54) which focuses on more recent developments in church history and in practical theology.

Komonchak, Joseph A., Mary Collins and Dermot A. Lane, eds. *The New Dictionary of Theology*. Wilmington, Del.: Michael Glazier, 1987.

Signed articles of uneven length; twenty-four topics are examined in major entries. Hindered by lack of indexing, although there are some cross-references. Selective bibliographies cite both Protestant and Roman Catholic works.

Muller, Richard A. *Dictionary of Latin and Greek Theological Terms*. Grand Rapids, Mich.: Baker Book House, 1985.

Drawn principally from Protestant Scholastic theology. Several thousand theological terms and short phrases are translated, many of which include extended historical definitions and usages. Important for placing terms in theological context. Many words are cross-indexed.

Musser, Donald W. and Joseph L. Price, eds. *A New Handbook of Christian Theology*. Nashville: Abingdon Press, 1992.

Signed articles by major theologians on theological terms and doctrinal concepts

———, eds. *A New Handbook of Christian Theologians*. Nashville: Abingdon Press, 1996.

Concise summaries of the thought of fifty-four influential theologians with a particular emphasis on the theological movements of the past three decades. Reflects the geographical, regional expansion of theological horizon and the proliferation of new voices that have resulted in the present contextual diversity of theology

Peerman, Dean G. and Martin E. Marty, eds. *A Handbook of Christian Theologians*. Enl. ed. Nashville: Abingdon Press, 1984.

Well-written summaries of the thought of thirty-eight influential theologians of the past one hundred and fifty years. Contributors are themselves well-known scholars

Pelikan, Jaroslav Jan, ed. *Twentieth Century Theology in the Making*. 1st Harper pbk. ed. 3 vols. New York: Harper & Row, 1971.

Translations from the second edition of the RGG (see *Die Religion in Geschichte und Gegenwart* above) with selected articles by Troeltsch, Hamack, Barth, Tillich, and others.

Rahner, Karl. *Sacramentum Mundi: An Encyclopedia of Theology*. 6 vols. New York: Herder and Herder, 1968.

Six volumes, including index. Considered a "Summa" of modern Roman Catholic theology, incorporates a post-Vatican II viewpoint. Contains over one thousand articles by more than six hundred international scholars. Selective bibliographies. General index, list of contributors in volume 6.

———, ed. *Encyclopedia of Theology : The Concise Sacramentum Mundi*. New York: Seabury Press, 1975.

Contains revised versions of major articles from *Sacramentum Mundi* and other works as well as entirely new articles. Entries are signed; no bibliographies.

Richardson, Alan, ed. *A Dictionary of Christian Theology*. Philadelphia: Westminster Press, 1969.

Contains excellent articles on the classical formulations of major doctrines, e.g., Christology, Atonement, Holy Spirit, etc. Longer entries include brief bibliographies.

Richardson, Alan and John Stephen Bowden, eds. *The Westminster Dictionary of Christian Theology*. Philadelphia: Westminster Press, 1983.

This work differs from its predecessor (see A Dictionary of Christian Theology above) in offering articles on more recent theological developments and interests, e.g., the relation of theology to other disciplines and to other religions, theologies of liberation, religious language, etc.. Contributors are major contemporary theologians from a broad theological and confessional spectrum. Selective bibliographies.

Vacant, Alfred, Eugène Managenot and Emile Amann, eds. *Dictionnaire De Théologie Catholique, Contenant L'exposé Des Doctrines De La Théologie Catholique, Leurs Preuves Et Leur Histoire*. 15 vols. Paris: Letouzey et Ané, 1903.

Fifteen volumes plus indices in supplements. Substantial articles on modern European (especially French) theology and its historical development. Particularly strong in medieval theology.

Viller, Marcel, Ferdinand Cavallera and J. de Guibert, eds. *Dictionnaire De Spiritualité Ascétique Et Mystique, Doctrine Et Histoire*. 17 vols. Paris: G. Beauchesne et ses fils, 1932.

Seventeen volumes have been published to date. Surveys and details significant spiritual movements in North African and Byzantine history as well as those of Western Europe. Substantial bibliographies cite French sources almost exclusively.

Ziefle, Helmut W. *Dictionary of Modern Theological German*. 2nd ed. Grand Rapids, Mich.: Baker Book House, 1992.

Over 20,000 entries with brief definitions. Strong in biblical studies, weaker in the theological disciplines. Includes appendices of irregular verbs and the books of the Bible

Bibliographical review journal, primarily of Spanish and German, occasionally of French and English books. Similar to Religious Studies Review (see below), in that review essays are accompanied by major book reviews and categorized book notes.

Journal of the American Academy of Religion. Vol. 1-, 1933-. Chico, Calif.: American Academy of Religion.

Scholarly articles on all aspects of religion. Strong book review section.

American Journal of Theology & Philosophy. Vol. 1-, 1980-. West Lafayette, Ind.: American Journal of Theology & Philosophy.

Particular concern for theological reflection on social and cultural issues. Book reviews.

Anglican Theological Review. Vol. 1-, May 1918-. Milwaukee, Wisc.: Marquette University.

Articles on a variety of topics in Christian theology. Good book review section

Published by Association for Theological Education in South East Asia in collaboration with North East Asia Association of Theological Schools and Serampore College. Scholarly articles with book reviews.

The Christian Century. Vol. 1-, 1902-. Chicago: Christian Century Co.

American Protestant counterpart to *The Tablet* (see below). Theological and religious news; reflection upon and analysis of current events. Prompt reviews of major new books in religion and related fields.

Christian Scholar's Review. Vol. 1-, 1970-. Wenham, Mass.

From classical orthodox perspective. Scholarly articles on theological, historical, and philosophical topics. Book reviews.

Dialog. Vol. 1-, 1962-. St. Paul, Minn.: Dialog.

Lutheran publication. Articles reflect concern for ecclesial implications of theological issues. Thematic articles. Good book reviews.

Études Théologiques Et Religieuses. Vol. 1-, 1926-. Montpellier, France: Université. Faculté Libre de Théologie Protestante de Montpellier.

Major French Protestant journal. Significant research articles and extensive book reviews across disciplines

Evangelische Theologie. Vol. 1-, 1934-. München: C. Kaiser.

German Protestant publication. Research articles on classical and contemporary theological themes. No book reviews.

Faith and Philosophy: Journal of the Society of Christian Philosophers. Vol. 1-, 1984-. Wilmore, KY: The Society of Christian Philosophers.

Articles by many of the outstanding philosophers and theologians in the classical orthodox tradition. Good book reviews.

Feminist Theology. Vol. 1-, 1992-. Sheffield, England: Sheffield Academic Press.

The subtitle notwithstanding, it includes and reflects diverse feminist viewpoints with articles by Latin American, African and Asian contributors. Research articles and constructive proposals. Book reviews.

The Greek Orthodox Theological Review. Vol. 1-, 1954-. Brookline, Mass.: Holy Cross School of Theology Hellenic College.

Published by Holy Cross School of Theology. Reflects North American Greek Orthodox viewpoints. Scholarly articles with good book reviews.

Heythrop Journal: A Quarterly Review of Philosophy and Theology. Vol. 1-, 1960. Oxford: Heythrop College.

Published by Jesuit college at Oxford. Articles on classical and contemporary themes in philosophy and theology. Very good book review section.

Horizons. Vol. 1-, 1974-. Villanova, Pa.: College Theology Society.

The journal of the College Theology Society. Predominantly Catholic perspective. Articles on a variety of topics, often with emphasis on the Continental tradition. Very good book reviews.

Journal of Ecumenical Studies. Vol. 1-, 1964-. Philadelphia.: Temple University.

Published by Council on the Study of Religion. Articles on the ecumenical issues and cross-cultural, inter-religious dialogue. Extensive book reviews

The Journal of Religion. Vol. 1-, 1921-. Chicago: University of Chicago Press.

Distinguished scholars write on a variety of topics in religious studies. Excellent book reviews in format of review articles.

Journal of the Evangelical Theological Society. Vol. 12-, 1969-. Wheaton, Ill.: Evangelical Theological Society.

Continues the Bulletin of the Evangelical Society. Articles in Biblical theology, conservative theological analysis. Book reviews.

Journal of Theological Studies. Vol. 1-50, 1899-1949; new series, vol.1-, 1950-. London.

Extensive review section, with emphasis on British books.

Kerygma Und Dogma. Vol. 1-, 1955-. Göttingen: Vandenhoeck & Ruprecht.

Scholarly articles of historical or systematic nature, with an emphasis on doctrines and history of their development. No book reviews.

Literature and Theology. Vol. 1-, 1987-. Oxford: Oxford University Press.

Interdisciplinary journal devoted to the dialogue of theology with literature, philosophy and cultural studies. Significant research articles with good book reviews

Modern Theology. Vol. 1-, 1984-. Oxford: Basil Blackwell.

Specializes in the relation between theology and other disciplines, especially philosophy. Features analyses of contemporary constructive programs. Book reviews.

Neue Zeitschrift Für Systematische Theologie Und Religionsphilosophie. Vol. 1-, 1963-. Berlin: W. de Gruyter.

Significant scholarly articles by international contributors, with english abstracts. Short book reviews by an editor.

Nouvelle Revue Théologique. Vol. 1-, 1868-. Tournai: Casterman (Centre de documentation et de recherche religieuses de la compagnie de Jesus a Louvain).

French Jesuit publication. Articles with summaries and a good review section, especially for recent French publications in the theological disciplines.

Religious Studies. Vol. 1-, 1965-. London: Cambridge University Press.

Articles with summaries by distinguished British scholars, primarily from an AngloAmerican philosophical perspective. Very good reviews.

Religious Studies Review. Vol. 1-, 1975-. Hanover, Pa.: Council on the Study of Religion.

Published by the Council on the Study of Religion. The best American source for book reviews. Features both extended review articles and shorter notices by subject area. There is usually a bibliographic essay in each issue.

Revue De Théologie Et De Philosophie. Vol. 1-44, 1868-1911; new series, vol. 138, 1913-1950; series 3, vol. 1-, 1951-. Lausanne: Impr. La Concorde (Schweizerische Geisteswissenschaftliche Gesellschaft).

Very good book reviews for works in history of religions, biblical studies, contemporary theology, and philosophy.

Sal Terrae. Vol. 1-, 1912-. Santander: Sal terrae.

Representative monthly Latin American journal devoted to issues of liberation theology and pastoral theology. Contains book reviews.

Scottish Journal of Theology. Vol. 1-, 1948-. Edinburgh.

Scholarly articles on historical and philosophical theology from a classical orthodox perspective. Very good book reviews

Studies in World Christianity. Vol. 1-, 1995-. . Edinburgh: Edinburgh University Press.

Articles on Christianity in non-Western contexts and inter-religious encounters. Book reviews.

The Tablet. Vol. 1-, 1840-. London: Tablet Pub. Co.

English Roman Catholic weekly which analyzes current events. Includes book reviews as well as reviews of art, theatre, records, television, and movies.

Jesuit publication that is perhaps the leading American Roman Catholic theological journal.
Extensive book review section.

Research articles in biblical studies, history of doctrine and contemporary theology, with both German and English abstracts. Good book reviews

Theologie Und Philosophie. Vol. 1-, 1926-. Freiburg: Herder.

Articles on theological and philosophical topics, both historical and contemporary. Good book reviews.

Theologische Literaturzeitung. Edited by Emil Schürer and Adolf von Harnack. Vol. 1-, 1876-. Berlin.: Evangelische Verlagsanstalt.

German Protestant review. Works classified by broad theological categories. Occasional bibliographies of single author. Includes festschriften and unpublished dissertations.

Theologische Quartalschrift. Vol. 1-, 1819-. Stuttgart: E. Wewel.

Includes bibliographical surveys of research in specific areas. Good book reviews, including festschriften.

Theologische Revue. Vol. 1-, 1902-. Münster: Universität Münster. Katholisch-Theologische Fakultät.

German Roman Catholic review. Bibliographic essays on theological topics, considering both books and articles. Extensive book reviews.

Theologische Rundschau. Edited by Wilhelm Bousset and Rudolf Karl Bultmann. Vol. 1-20, 1897-1917; new series, vol. 1-, 1929-. Tübingen: J.C.B. Mohr.

Extended review articles with occasional surveys of developments in the literature of the field. Also shorter reviews of recently published books.

Theologische Zeitschrift. Vol. 1-, 1945-. Basel: F. Reinhardt ag. (Universität Basel. Theologische Fakultät).

Articles on historical theology. Book reviews, listings of dissertations in progress. Occasional surveys of current periodical literature.

Theology Digest. Vol. 1-, 1953-. St. Louis, Mo.: School of Divinity of St. Louis University (St. Mary's College St. Mary's Kan.).

Selected translations of foreign journal articles with a book survey.

Theology Today. Vol. 1-, 1944-. Princeton, NJ; Ephrata, PA: Princeton Theological Seminary; Science Press.

Scholarly articles by distinguished contributors on a variety of theological and biblical themes. Major review articles, extensive review sections, and notices.

Outstanding Roman Catholic journal, devoted to philosophical and theological analysis. Distinguished contributors. Significant research articles; extended review section, often with review symposia; shorter notices

Zeitschrift Für Katholische Theologie. Edited by Universität Innsbruck. Theologische Fakultät. Vol. 1-, 1877-. Wien: Herder.

Prominent German Roman Catholic journal. Significant research articles with english abstracts. Extensive book reviews.

Zeitschrift Für Theologie Und Kirche. Vol. 1-, 1891-. Tübingen: Mohr.

Prominent German Protestant publication. Significant research articles in biblical studies, history of doctrine and contemporary theology, with English abstracts. No book reviews

Zygon. Edited by Joint Publication Board of the Institute on Religion in an Age of Science and Meadville Theological School. Vol. 1-, 1965-. Chicago: University of Chicago Press.

Scholarly articles explore the relationship of science and theology. Many papers come from seminars and consortia on religion and science. Book reviews.
